Required Screenings

Pre-School	Distance Visual Acuity, Stereopsis
Kindergarten / 1st	Distance Visual Acuity, Stereopsis, Color (for boys only)
Grades 3, 5, 7, 9, 11	Distance Visual Acuity
Any student enrolling in a school for the first time with no documentation of a vision screening: Distance Visual Acuity, Stereopsis, Color (for boys only)	


Preschool Vision Screening Monocular Distance

Image and Visual Acuity Test	Referral Criteria	School Age
<p>#19020 Vision in Preschool Screener Set</p> 	<p>A referral is made if a child misses 2 or more of the first 4 symbols or 2 or more of the second 4 symbols on the disk for either the right OR the left eye. If a child misses 2 or more symbols during presentation of the baseline cards.</p>	<p>3, 4 and 5 year olds</p>
<p>#18165 EyE Check Flipbook 20/40</p> 	<p>If a child misses 2 or more symbols on cards 5 to 8 OR cards 9 to 12 in the flipbook for either the right OR left eye then a referral is made.</p>	<p>4 and 5 years old</p>
<p>#19016 EyE Check Flipbook 20/50</p> 	<p>If a child misses 2 or more symbols on cards 5 to 8 OR cards 9 to 12 in the flipbook for either the right OR left eye then a referral is made.</p>	<p>3 years old</p>

Image and Visual Acuity Test	Referral Criteria	School Age
<p>#19014 PASS 2 Smile Test</p> 	<p>If a five year old child does not correctly identify 2 out of 2 cards B or 4 out of 4 out of 5 presentations on Card C.</p>	<p>K and 1st or initial screening</p>

Preschool Vision Screening Optional Near Vision Acuity




Image and Visual Acuity Test	Referral Criteria	School Age
<p>#250800 LEA SYMBOLS® Near Vision Card</p> 	<p>A referral is made on a child whose visual acuity is 20/40 or worse with both eyes. To pass the LEA SYMBOLS® chart with a 16" cord, a child must be able to identify 3 out of 3 or 3 out of 4 symbols on the passing line, which is 20/32, with both eyes together.</p>	<p>Preschool</p>

Note: If the child has a two line difference between his/her eyes (e.g., reads 20/32 and 20/50 in the other eye). The difference may be an indication of Amblyopia and a referral should be made.

School Age Color Vision Test

Image and Visual Acuity Test	Referral Criteria	School Age
<p>#15124 Color Check Complete Vision Screener</p> 	<p>Follow the manufacturer's guidelines. Notification of results to parents and teachers is necessary. Utilize the parent Color Vision Letter (Letter C).</p>	<p>K or 1st or initial screening</p>

<p>#2106C Sloan Letters Near Vision Card</p>  <p>#12302 HOTV Near Vision Card</p>  <p>#250800 LEA SYMBOLS® Near Vision Card</p> 	<p>A referral is made on a child whose visual acuity is 20/40 or worse with both eyes. To pass the letters or LEA SYMBOLS® with a 16" cord, a child must be able to identify 3 out of 3 or 3 out of 4 symbols on the passing line, which is 20/32, with both eyes together.</p>	<p>K, 1st, 3rd, 5th, 7th, 9th and 11th</p>

Note: If the child has a two line difference between his/her eyes (e.g., reads 20/32 and 20/50 in the other eye). The difference may be an indication of Amblyopia and a referral should be made
