Section 2, Hazard(s) identification

Potential health effects: -Eye Contact: Not expected to present a hazard to the eyes under normal conditions of use but direct contact of the impregnating fluid with the eyes may cause slight transitory irritation.

-Skin Contact: This product is expected to contact with skin.

-Inhalation: Not expected to present an inhalation hazard under normal conditions of use.

-Ingestion: Not expected to present an ingestion hazard under normal conditions of use.

Section 3, Composition/information on ingredients

An aqueous solution of a proprietary blend of humectant, solubiliser, emollient, nonionic surfactant, amphoteric surfactant and a preservative system impregnated onto a non-woven fabric.



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Product ingredients: Aqua, Cetearyl Isonanoate, Glycerin, Cetearth-20, Caprylic Capric Triglyceride, Propylene Glycol, Aloe Vera, Cetearth-12, Glyceryl Stearate, Diazolidinyl Urea, Polysorbate 20, Methylparaben, Phenoxyethanol, PEG40 Castor Oil, Fragrance, Lanolin.

Section 4, First-aid measures

General: In all cause of doubt, or when symptoms persist, seek medical attention.

Eye contact: Rinse immediately with plenty of water, also under the eye lids, for at least 15minutes, Obtain medical attention if irritation persists.

Inhalation: Move to fresh air. Seek medical advice if cough, shortness of breath or other respiratory problems occur.

Skin contact: Seek medical advice if redness, swelling, itching or burning occur..

Ingestion: Not a likely route. Call a physician or poison control center immediately.

Section 5, Fire-fighting measures

State: Non-woven fabric wipes impregnated with a colorless solution

Flammability: Non-flammable

Solubility: Impregnating fluid completely miscible with water

Section 10, Stability and reactivity

Stability: This preparation is stable under normal conditions of storage/use and no chemical incompatibility is known.

Section 11, Toxicological information

General: Based on the ingredients present and their concentrations, this preparation is, according to the conventional method of Directive 1999/45/EC and subsequent amendments, classified as not 'Dangerous' according to health criteria.

Acute oral: The oral LD50 (rat) value for the impregnating fluid calculated from those of the individual ingredients is >10,000 mg/kg.

Section 12, Ecological information

General: Based on the ingredients present and their concentrations, this preparation is, according to the conventional method of Directive 1999/45/EC and subsequent amendments, classified as not 'Dangerous' to the environment. The surfactant ingredients contained in this preparation comply with the biodegradability criteria as laid down in Regulation (EC) 648/2004.
